Chapter Pottery will be sold in four phases **Phase 1, for Fredericksburg chapter members only, will proceed as follows:**

- 1. Time and Location:
 - a. June 17th, starting at 6:15PM in the Baker Room
 - b. Chapter members can arrive as early as 6:00PM to get a place in line to purchase pottery.
 - c. No one can" hold a place" in line for someone who has not already arrived and obtained their place in line first. If a person in line needs to step out temporarily, then a person in front or behind them can hold the place.
- 2. Pottery to be sold in limited quantities:
 - a. The 29 place settings (tea cup, saucer, 7 inch lunch plate and 9 inch dinner plate); single lunch plates, single dinner plates, single saucers and the chapter #34 teacups with saucers will be sold.
 - b. Each chapter member will be allowed to purchase one place setting and an additional lunch plate, dinner plate and/or saucer.
 - c. If you do not want a place setting, you can buy up to 2 each of the dinner plates, lunch plates and saucers.
 - d. In addition to the above, a member can purchase one of the Chapter #34 teacup and saucer sets.

- 4. It will be processed after the June stated in the order received. We do not guarantee availability. You will need to pick up the pottery by the next stated meeting, Jul 15th. If you want it shipped, you will have to pay for the shipping before it is shipped. We cannot be held responsible for the safety of the item during shipping.

Phase 2 for Fredericksburg #29 chapter members only will precede as follows:

- 1. Time and Location:
 - a. July15th stated meeting, starting at 6:15PM in the Baker Room
 - b. Chapter members can arrive as early as 6:00PM to take a seat before it begins.
 - c. In this sale you can have a chapter member act as your proxy if you are prevented from arriving in time.
- 2. Pottery to be sold:
 - a. The 4 platters: 3 in good condition, 1 is chipped
 - b. The 3 Pitchers: 2 are in good condition, 1 has a crack
 - c. The 5 sugar bowls with lids
- 3. Selling process: In order to be as equitable as possible to members with or without unlimited funds, we will conduct a separate drawing (no silent auctions) for the platters, the pitchers and the sugar bowls. It is assumed that there are more people that want an the limited pottery items then there are items.
 - a. Every member who wants one of the limited quantity pottery items will put their name in a drawing for the specific item, at the time of the drawing.

 - c. You cannot buy pottery for yourself and an absent member until all members present have had their opportunity to purchase pottery. You must take the absent members pottery with you.

It will be processed after the Aug stated. We do not guarantee availability. You will need to pick up the pottery by the next stated meeting. If you want it shipped, you will have to pay for the shipping before it is shipped. We cannot be held responsible for the safety of the item during shipping.
